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The Charles R. Craig Scholarship is offered annually to a graduating senior of Kettering Fairmont High School. The award may be applied to tuition, room and board and other related educational expenses at an accredited two or four year college, university or trade school.

Scholarship Criteria

- Be a graduating senior from Fairmont High School.
- Be a member of the Fairmont Music Department.
- Have a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Be accepted at an accredited two or four-year college or university or a two-year technical school*.

Application Process

- Complete the scholarship application (available on the KEF website) and mail it to the Kettering Education Foundation by the deadline date.
- Attach to the application.
 - The completed copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) summary page from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). THE FAFSA REPORT IS THE **ONLY** ELIGIBLE REPORT, PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT TAX RETURNS OR W2'S.
 - A transcript of grades through the seventh semester.
 - One recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, community or church leader.
 - An autobiography describing any pertinent information regarding the desire to receive this award (maximum of 750 pages typed, double spaced.)

Criteria for selection applicant(s) who show combination of Essay, Financial need, and music department involvement, GPA, and activities.

Size and frequency of the Charles R. Craig Scholarship Fund. One \$500 scholarship will be offered annually; However, the Charles R. Craig Scholarship Selection Committee may elect to change the amount or number of scholarships award; or not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified.

Use of the Charles R. Craig Scholarship. The Charles R. Craig Scholarship may be used for tuition, room/board and related educational expenses.
