

THE COOKIE WEEKS SCHOLARSHIP of the Kettering Education Foundation

The Cookie Weeks Scholarship was established by Cookie Weeks to assist a graduating Fairmont senior who was also a graduate of Ms. Week's Beavertown Elementary class. The award is a \$1,000 one-year scholarship and will be given to a student who has a combination of a high GPA, and demonstrated involvement in school and community activities.

Scholarship Criteria

- Be a graduating senior from Fairmont High School
- Be a graduate of Beavertown Elementary and have attended Cookie Weeks's class
- Be accepted at an accredited two or four-year college or university or a two-year technical school*
- Not have been awarded an athletic scholarship

Application Process

- Submit the scholarship application with the following attachments:
 - One recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, community or church leader.
 - A transcript of grades through the seventh semester
 - A letter or verification of attendance from Beavertown Elementary School
 - An essay consisting of no more than 500 words on the subject. **"Why I would like to further my education."**

Criteria for selection:

GPA, demonstrated involvement in community and school activities, essay, and recommendation

Size and frequency of the Scholarship:

One \$1,000 scholarship will be offered annually; however, the Cookie Weeks Scholarship Selection Committee may elect to change the amount or number of scholarships awarded; or not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified.

Use of the Scholarship:

The Cookie Weeks Scholarship may be used for tuition and related educational expenses.

Payment of the Scholarship:

The Selection Committee will submit the names of the recommended scholarship recipients to The Dayton Foundation's Governing Board on an annual basis. The scholarships will be paid directly to the students' schools after the students have confirmed enrollment.
