The James Lockwood Scholarship was established at the wishes of James Lockwood, who was killed by a drunk driver in a traffic accident just days before deploying for service in Iraq. The scholarship is designed to award an individual who has been a member of the Fairmont Track & Field program, and has exhibited significant love and spirit for this program while not necessarily being a stand out athlete. The James Lockwood Scholarship is a one time scholarship award of \$5,000.

To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior from Fairmont High School.
- Be accepted at an accredited two or four-year college or university or a two-year technical school*.
- Been a member of the Fairmont Track & Field Program.
- Been a student that has demonstrated love for the track & field program, while not necessarily exhibiting significant accomplishments in this sport.
- Must be an academically challenged student.
- Must demonstrate financial need.
- Needs to be recommended by current track coach.

Interested individuals should submit a completed application form and include the following attachments:

1. A list of school activities as required on the application.
2. Two recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, community or church leader.
3. Current transcripts.

Criteria for selection include: participation in school, work, financial need, and coach recommendation.

Size and frequency of the James Lockwood Scholarship. One scholarship with a minimum gift of \$5,000 will be offered annually; However, the James Lockwood Scholarship Selection Committee may elect to change the amount or number of scholarships award; or not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified.

Use of the James Lockwood Scholarship. The James Lockwood Scholarship may be used for tuition, room/board and related educational expenses.
