THE MARY LOU HOLLAND

The Mary Lou Holland was established by Mary Lou Holland to assist a graduating Fairmont senior that was also a graduate of her Beavertown Elementary class. The award is a \$1,000 one-year scholarship and will be given to a student that has a combination of high GPA, is active in the community and school, and show a financial need.

To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior from Fairmont High School.
- Be a graduate of Beavertown Elementary and have attended Mary Lou Holland's class.
- Be accepted at an accredited two or four-year college or university or a two-year technical school*.
- Submit a completed application form and include the following attachments:
 1. A list of activities as required on the application.
 2. A list of community service activities as required on the application.
 3. Last years tax returns for the entire household. If parents are separated or file separately both tax returns must be submitted.
 4. Two recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, community or church leader.

Criteria for selection applicant(s) who show combination of high GPA, is active in the community and their school, and show a financial need.

Size and frequency of the Mary Lou Holland. One \$1,000 scholarship will be offered annually; However, the Mary Lou Holland Scholarship Selection Committee may elect to change the amount or number of scholarships award; or not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified.

Use of the Mary Lou Holland. The Mary Lou Holland Scholarship may be used for tuition, room/board and related educational expenses.
