

THE RAY ALBRECHT SCHOLARSHIP

of the Kettering Education Foundation

The Ray Albrecht Scholarship was established by the family of Ray Albrecht as a memorial tribute to the hard work and dedication that he showed in all aspects of his life, and for his commitment to sending eleven kids and six grandkids through the Kettering School System. The Scholarship will benefit individuals graduating from the Fairmont Alternative Program who have demonstrated a hard work ethic and substantial academic improvement.

To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior from Fairmont High School's Alternative School
- Be accepted at an accredited two or four-year college or university or a two-year technical school*

Submit a completed application form and include the following attachments:

1. The completed copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) summary page from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). THE FAFSA REPORT IS THE **ONLY** ELIGIBLE REPORT, PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT TAX RETURNS OR W2'S
2. A transcript of grades through the seventh semester
3. One recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, employer, coach, community or church leader
4. Maintain a part or full time job for the majority of the school year

Criteria for selection:

Participation in school, employment history, GPA improvement, financial need, and recommendations

Selection Process:

The Selection of a recipient will be made by a committee appointed by The Dayton Foundation

Size and frequency of the Scholarship:

One scholarship with a minimum gift of \$1,000 will be offered annually; however, the Ray Albrecht Scholarship Selection Committee may elect to change the amount or number of scholarships awarded; or not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified

Use of the Scholarship:

The Ray Albrecht Scholarship may be used for tuition and related educational expenses
