## THE THOM & PENNI MEYER SCHOLARSHIP

The Thom & Penni Meyer Scholarship was established by Nick O'Donnell family to pay tribute to Thom & Penni Meyer and the profound impact that they had on his life and the many other students they have taught through the years. The award is a \$500 one-year scholarship and will be judged on financial need, community activities, their essay and photographic portfolio.

### **To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must:**

- Be a graduating senior from Fairmont High School..
- Be accepted at an accredited two or four-year college or university or a two-year technical school\*.
- Submit a completed application form and include the following attachments:
  1. A list of activities as required on the application.
  2. A list of community service activities as required on the application.
  3. The completed copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) summary page from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). THE FAFSA REPORT IS THE **ONLY** ELIGIBLE REPORT, PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT TAX RETURNS OR W2'S.
  4. A transcript of grades through the seventh semester showing a GPA of 3.5 or higher.
  5. One recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, community or church leader.
  6. Photographic portfolio containing no less than 3 distinct pieces of photographic art.

**Criteria for selection** financial need, community activities, essay and photographic portfolio.

**Size and frequency of the Thom & Penni Meyer Scholarship.** One \$500 scholarship will be offered annually; However, the Thom & Penni Meyer Scholarship Selection Committee may elect to change the amount or number of scholarships award; or not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified.

**Use of the Thom & Penni Meyer Scholarship.** The Thom & Penni Meyer Scholarship may be used for tuition, room/board and related educational expenses.
